Political Committee: Reporting Multiple Uniform Contributions (MUCs)

Section 106.07(4)(b), Fla. Stat. - Multiple uniform contributions from the same person, aggregating no more than \$250 per calendar year, collected by an organization that is the affiliated sponsor of a political committee, may be reported by the political committee in an aggregate amount listing the number of contributors together with the amount contributed by each and the total amount contributed during the reporting period. The identity of each person making such uniform contribution must be reported to the filing officer as provided in subparagraph (a)1. by July 1 of each calendar year, or, in a general election year, no later than the 60th day immediately preceding the primary election.

Persons who contribute more than \$250 in a calendar year must be reported individually on campaign treasurer's reports.

Contributions are not required to be aggregated. However, if the political committee aggregates contributions, then a MUC report must be filed with the filing office after the end of the calendar year, but no later than July 1 in non-general election years or no later than 60 days prior to the primary election in general election years. The report must include:

The contributor's name;

The contributor's address; and,

The contributor's occupation, if the aggregate contribution exceeded \$100 in a calendar year.

If a political committee does not utilize the MUC method of reporting, the political committee must file a waiver of the MUC Report with the filing officer.
