

## Administration

- Acts as the Secretary of State's designee to coordinate, interpret, implement and enforce election laws
- Supervises the Division's 3 Bureaus that provide election-related assistance to the 67 supervisors of elections' offices, elections' officials, cities, special districts, county and city attorneys, candidates, political entities, the media, and the public
- Oversees the administration of the federal grants under the Help America Vote Act and the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services (HHS)
- Oversees the entire budget process and expenditures for the Division of Elections

## **Specific Duties**

- Advisory opinions
- Rules and regulations to implement election laws including uniform standards for voter registration procedures and statewide form
- Technical assistance to the supervisors of elections on voter education, voting system and election personnel training services.
- Statistical data collection and reporting for public, educational, political and governmental purposes including analysis on the effectiveness of election administration and election laws

## **Duties**

- Coordination with the United States Department of Defense Federal Voting Assistance Program (FVAP) to monitor and assess overseas and military absentee voting under the Uniformed and Overseas Citizen's Absentee Voter Act (UOCAVA), Military and Overseas Voter Empowerment Act (MOVE) & other federal laws
- Coordination with U.S. Election Assistance Commission regarding inquiries and surveys on election administration and voting
- Coordination/oversight of the state's responsibilities under the National Voter Registration Act of 1993 (NVRA)

## **Duties**


- Qualifying and campaign forms and manuals to assist campaigns, candidates, and political entities to comply with qualifying, accounting and reporting requirements (Ch.106, F.S.)
- Voter education assistance and voter fraud hotline
- Constitutional amendments:
  - Oversees the process by which citizens propose constitutional amendments by initiative
  - Ballot position placement process
  - Public notice of constitutional amendments.
  - Spanish translation

## Duties


- Qualifying and campaign forms and manuals to assist campaigns, candidates, and political entities to comply with qualifying, accounting and reporting requirements (Chapter 106, Fla. Stat.)
- Conferences- Coordinates with the Florida State Association of Supervisors of Elections to give election law updates and ensure statewide compliance and uniformity with election laws
- Training courses/continuing education-Oversees and approves training courses for supervisors of elections to obtain special salary certification
- Legislative proposals and bill analyses on proposed electionrelated bills





Noon, April 14, 2014 – Noon, April 18, 2014

Governor and Cabinet, State Senator, State Representative, County Office and Special Districts

Noon, June 2, 2014 – Noon, June 6, 2014

#### Voter Registration Book Closing Dates

#### Absentee Ballot Dates

Deadline to send absentee ballots to UOCAVA voters (absent stateside and overseas uniformed services voters and overseas civilian voters):

Primary Election......June 28, 2014 General Election.....September 20, 2014

Deadline (7-day window) to mail domestic absentee ballots to domestic (non-UOCAVA) absentee voters:

#### 2013 DATES TO REMEMBER

January 31 Supervisors to certify list maintenance activities to the Division (Sections 98.065 and 98.075, F.S. – No later than January 31 of each year)


Deadline for Department of State to submit survey results from Supervisors of Elections to the U.S. Election Assistance Commission

April 14 Deadline for U.S. Senator, U.S. Representative, and State Attorney or Public Defender candidates to change party affiliation. (Section 99.021, F.S. – 365 days before the beginning of qualifying preceding the general election)

June 2 Deadline for Governor and Cabinet, State Senator, State
Representative, County Office and Special District candidates to
change party affiliation, (Section 99.021, F.S. – 365 days before the
beginning of qualifying preceding the general election)

December 31 Supervisors of Elections should review General Records Retention
Schedule 3 for Election Records and conduct public records
retention/management for public records that are ready for disposition.

Compliance: The Division of Elections shall maintain a database of all third-party voter

registration organizations (3PVROs) and the voter registration forms assigned to the 3PVRO. Each Supervisor of Elections shall provide to the division information on voter registration forms assigned to and received from 3PVROs. The information must be provided in a format and at times as

required by the division by rule.

Purpose: To ensure the integrity of the registration process, including rules requiring

3PVROs to account for all state and federal registration forms used by their registration agents. The Division of Elections must update information on

3PVROs daily and make the information publicly available.

Record Retention: To be determined

Forms to be Used: DS-DE 124 (available on the Division of Elections website at

http://election.dos.state.fl.us/forms/index.shtml)

Submission Date: By noon, each day. If the Supervisor of Elections' office is closed on the day

a report is due, the supervisor or designee shall submit the report for the preceding business day on the next business day the office is open. Pursuant to Rule 1S-2.042 the DS-DE 124 is not required to be submitted if the SOE did not provide

applications to, or receive any from, a 3PVRO on the preceding business day.

#### Instructions:

- (1) By noon each day, complete form DS-DE 124 recording the number of state and federal voter registration applications provided to, and the number of state and federal blank and non-blank applications received from, each 3PVRO the previous day.
  - (2) Send the form to the Division of Elections as an email attachment in .pdf format or by fax.
